Four Little Steps to Death

- Most of us don't think we could murder someone or plot?
- King David would have been voted least likely to sin...
- Did he shirk his duty? When kings go out to battle...
- David didn't plan this... it happened late one afternoon...
- Remember David was chosen by God a man after God's own heart!
- Beware of the danger of sin James 1:15 this is life & death!

The First Dangerous Step - Shirking Our Duty

- David didn't plan this, he simply did nothing David as king had duty^{158:20}

- We were created by God to work for His glory Lie: pleasing ourselves will make us happy (smells of smoke) Jesus taught us to serve Him to save our lives Mark8:34-35
- 4 G's of Gospel living are so helpful:
 - God is Great so I don't have to be in control He is!
 - God is Glorious so I don't have to fear others fear Him!
 - God is Good-so I don't have to look elsewhere- God is all I need!
 - God is Gracious so I don't have to prove myself I'm accepted in Jesus by faith alone!
- Gospel yourself daily in these truths!

Step Two: Indulging the Flesh

- David likely didn't go to the roof to spy on pretty women
- Bathsheba likely didn't bath so others would see her
- David saw and didn't look away he indulged himself
- Eyes can get us in trouble Gen3:6 Adam & Eve lived by sight not faith
- David's sin was to inquire and entertain ideas
- Married=adultery; wife of faithful mighty man...

Step Three: Acting on our Impulses

- David committed 3 kinds of Adultery TimChester
- Spiritual Adultery
 - our relationship with Christ is like a marriage Eph5:32; Rev19:7
 - disobedience=something more precious than God
 - Heart Adultery
 - Jesus taught it starts in the heart Mt5:27-28
 - beware of the "if-only" thinking of our wicked heart
- Physical Adultery
 - narrator is brief4 but it is sin
 - David caused his servants to sin "pimp" for him
 - Why did no servant speak up? "Really just coffee with her?"
 - Probably thoughts before were better than actual sin^{Rom7:10-11;Prv5:3}

Step Four: Hiding the Sin

- the woman conceived David's sin was to be public
- So David begins the coverup get Uriah to sleep with his wife
- That failure leads to David plotting Uriah's murder

The Warnings & Lessons

- 1) we can use this as a shelter behind which we hide David sinned This even cost David dearly $^{\rm Ps32:3-4}$
- 2) this passage can trigger accusations you are condemned in sin David got the Gospel after confession Ps32:1-2 wrote Psalm103:10-12
- Beware how easy it is to fall into sin be every vigilant! Jer17:9;2Cor10:5
- God in the mystery of His providence overcomes the effects of sin and shame and He never abandons His own Heb4:14-16
